### 4-H Summer Camp July 25-29

Can you believe it? Summer Camp is just around the corner! Again this year we will be camping at Camp Susan, located just north of Antigo. All interested youth, currently  $2^{nd} - 7^{th}$  grade are invited. Non 4-H friends are also welcome. A bus will transport campers.

**Early Bird Registrations – by May 31<sup>st</sup>** \$90 for members, \$100 for non-members **Regular Registrations** – after May 31<sup>st</sup> \$100 for members, \$110 for non-members

There will be swimming, hiking, and other great outdoor activities planned! Registrations accepted until camp is full. Camp fees cover lodging, busing, meals, craft/canteen, and other miscellaneous expenses. Non-members fee also includes special insurance.

All 5<sup>th</sup> graders will have a day hike learning various camping & hiking skills and making their own lunch.

The 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> graders will have an <u>optional</u> campout which will be much more adventurous! This campout will leave camp to hike to their campsite, make their shelter, supper, learn more survival skills on the trail, sleep out and make breakfast on the trail before returning to camp! If you are a 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> grader and would like to participate in this campout, please indicate this on your registration so we can plan accordingly. # Livestock Members and Parents Reinstating THREE (3) Credit Requirement

A number of important jobs need to be completed during the County Fair to get ready for the Beef, Sheep and Swine Shows and Market Animal Sale. To get this work done, 4-H Clubs and FFA Chapters having Livestock Project members are assigned to various tasks to be completed each day. A "Fair Work Schedule" is listed on or near page 5 the Shawano County Fair Junior Fair Handbook (the "little blue book") that each of you receive with the July-August 4-H Clover Line Newsletter.

The Livestock Key Committee has noticed that it's been pretty much the same families doing all the work of setting up and taking down for the show and sale. For this reason, the, in 2017 the Livestock Key Committee will go back to requiring THREE MEETING CREDITS earned to sell in the fair livestock auction. One of these three meeting credits must be earned by working your assigned duties at the 2016 Shawano County Fair. This process will continue thereafter each year.

Livestock Key Committee will have signup sheets at the fair to record who is helping and who is not. Make sure you SIGN IN immediately after helping with your assigned duties. *Please talk about this at your club monthly meetings to make sure all families know about this new requirement.*

#### 2016 Shawano County Fair Market Animal Show/Sale Rule/Procedure Changes

- Initial weigh-ins for Beef, Sheep and Swine are reinstated.
- Exhibitors are responsible for ear tagging (prior to the weigh in day) and collecting a DNA sample from all animals to be shown at the Fair. Tags and DNA sample kits must be purchased from the Shawano County UW-Extension Office by May 11<sup>th</sup>. Exhibitors are responsible for sending DNA samples and registration forms to: Wisconsin Livestock Identification Consortium, ID/DNA Program, 135 Enterprise Drive, Suite ID, Verona, WI 53593-9987. Samples and registration forms must be postmarked by May 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Photos of the exhibitor and the animal (s)he is selling in the auction must be turned in to the Shawano County UW-Extension Office by August 1<sup>st</sup>. Photos may be mailed, but must be postmarked by August 1<sup>st</sup>.
- At present, the 2016 Shawano County Swine Show is <u>not</u> a terminal show. However, the Livestock Key Committee, as advised by the Wisconsin State Veterinarian, can invoke a terminal show at any time.
